Trains & Sight-seeing

*Thursday 27th December, 2018
to Tuesday 2nd January, 2019*

Following on from our previous NSW Wanderer tours over the New Year period it has been decided to run another such tour. We will actually go for a train ride this time and also have a look at some tourist sights which are a bit away from the beaten track.

Thu 27/12: Starting off from Roma Street (bus stop 122 outside Police Headquarters and opposite the Transit Centre) at 7.30am in our coach we will head west to Gatton, thence to Clifton, Leyburn and Inglewood for lunch. Southwards then to Texas where we cross into NSW to Yetman, Warialda and Moree for overnight. **D**

Fri 28/12: Following breakfast our coach delivers us to the railway station where we board the Xplorer train and travel to Scone. There will be about an hour in this pleasant country town before we hop on another Xplorer which will take us to Armidale. Our trusty coach will be waiting there to take us to our motel. **BD**

Sat 29/12: In our coach we take the road known as *Thunderbolt's Way* passing through Uralla and Walcha then through the Nowendoc National Park to Gloucester where lunch has been arranged. On the *Buckett's Way* now we go via Krumbach, Tinonee and Purfleet before heading to the seaside resort of Old Bar. There'll be time there for a look around as it's then but a short run to our overnight stop at Taree. Dinner has not been included tonight and you may make your own choice of meal at the nearby club. **BL**

Sun 30/12: The town of Wingham is on our way to the Ellenborough Falls which at 200m is one of the longest single-drop waterfalls in Australia. We will have morning tea here while admiring the view then head for Wauchope and the replica timber town of *Timbertown!* Time has been allowed for you to see the attractions such as the steam sawmill, blacksmith, working bullock team etc.

You can also take a steam train ride. The 595mm gauge track runs for 2.4km and crosses a lovely curved trestle bridge. You should also grab some lunch. Then it's off to the coast once more to visit Trial Bay Gaol, built to house prisoners constructing a safe harbour between Sydney and Brisbane. The scheme failed but the gaol was used as an internment camp during WW1. We call into the neighbouring town of South West Rocks then proceed to our overnight stop at Kempsey. **BD**

Mon 31/12: A short run up the Pacific Highway brings us to Macksville where we divert to Bowraville and the renowned Frank Partridge VC Military Museum. Then we follow the coast through the seaside resorts of Urunga & Sawtell and stop for lunch at Coffs Harbour. Still on the highway we go to Grafton then head bush. We travel through Baryulgil and Tabulam to Casino for overnight. **BD**

Tue 1/1: We follow the interstate railway north to Kyogle before cutting across some rather rough country to Uki and Murwillumbah. Then it's through Chillingham and across the border back into Queensland to visit Natural Bridge. We drop into Nerang for lunch before heading for home. This should get us back to Roma Street mid-afternoon. **B**

FARES: Fares Adults \$1,330.00 Seniors \$1,280.00

This fare includes 5 nights' motel accommodation on a share basis, all coach travel, train fares on the Xplorers, entry fees where required, **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner** as shown. Some single accommodation may be available on payment of a supplement – price on application.

REFRESHMENTS While travelling by coach, each day a stop will be made for morning tea (included in fare) and about an hour has been allowed for lunch.

RESERVATIONS: A deposit of \$200.00 will secure your place on this tour. Further payments may be made at any time with the full balance due by 15th November, 2018 when bookings close. Bookings may be made as shown overleaf.

CANCELLATION / REFUNDS: After bookings close on 15th November, 2018, a cancellation fee will be charged. The amount of such fee will be governed by any monies paid out for fares, charter or accommodation costs.

Tickets are available for the journey for which they are issued only. They are not transferable.

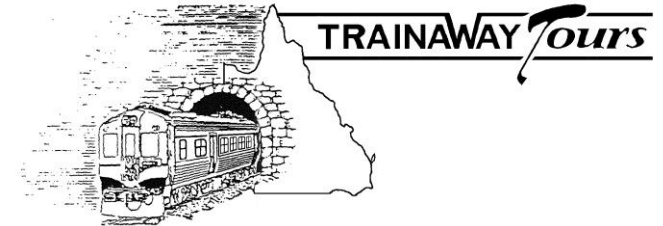
